PREMIERE OF HUBERMAN PRIZE CONCERTO

Alexander Boscowitch's Violin Concerto, which was awarded the Huberman Prize by the Palestine Orchestra on the occasion of the 60th birthday of the Orchestra's Founder, will receive its first public performance on Sunday night at a special P.O. Concert to take place in Tel Aviv at the Ohel Hall. The soloist will be Lorand Fenyves, and George Singer will conduct. The programme opens with Handel's Concerto Grosso in D minor and closes with Beethoven's 7th Symphony.

Boscowitch first became known to the Palestine public when Issay Dobrowen conducted his "Chansons Populaires Juives" in the P.O.'s 1937/38 subscription season. The composer came to Palestine for the premiere of his work and subsequently settled in the country. His Concerto for Oboe and Orchestra is to be played at the Orchestra's 9th subscription series which will be given at the end of March.
