It is our pleasure to inform you that your late husband, the composer Alexander Uriah Boskovich will be honored as the "Composer of the Year 2014-2015".

This coming September his music will be featured during the Israeli Music Celebration days from September 29<sup>th</sup> to October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014. Several of his works will be performed as part of the festival: the *Semitic Suite* for two pianos will be played in Ashdod, *Three Songs for Soprano and orchestra*, in Tel-Aviv, the Oboe Concerto will be played by the Jerusalem Symphony Orchestra at the Jerusalem Theater, and the suite *The Golden Chain* will be performed by the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra at the Opera House in Tel-Aviv.

A special part of the Festival booklet will be dedicated to his life and works, and a panel discussion about Boskovich's contribution to music criticism in Israel will take place. Personally, I am happy for the opportunity to reintroduce his music, as well as his writing about music, to the general public this year.

During the coming year, I hope to inform you of further performances of Boskovich's works by orchestras and chamber groups.
